Under the supervision of the director, the Student Graphic Aide performs the following:

Design outreach brochures and marketing materials.

Lead in the design and editing of the Asian American Resource Book.

Assist in the maintenance of AARCC website content.

Assist in the creation of listsery newsletters.

Provide customer service and respond to general inquiries via phone and e-mail.

Perform other general office support tasks.

Assist with the coordination of special events.

We expect these positions to require approximately 10-20 hours per week. These positions start at \$8.77/hour and are open to work-study (preferred – revise your FAFSA or contact Financial Aid to request work-study) and non-work-study students.
