# Role of the Interpreter

#### Conduit

- Interpreter's primary role
- Interprets from one language to another
- No omissions, additions, subtractions, or other changes/alterations
- 1st person language
- Reflects tone, volume, & inflection of the speaker

#### Clarifier

- Checks for & promotes understanding
  - o Lowering the complexity of speech
  - o Intervenes when necessary
- Asks speaker to clarify
  - o Requests permission to intervene (signal)
  - o Does not clarify on their own
- Establishes a pace

# Cultural Broker

- Objective & nonjudgmental
- Explains cultural-specific issues, attitudes, home-remedies, or other concepts to promote understanding
- Bridge between family & provider
- Educates provider before and during a session/meeting

- Family's right to understand
