Interns will assist in implementing mussel surveys and monitoring in selected rivers and lakes in Minnesota, Wisconsin and Iowa; to provide dive safety support, assist with laboratory propagation, and to assist with data entry resulting from mussel data collection and research as part of the statewide mussel survey, monitoring, and restoration program.
