



What? Fieldwork will include conducting radio telemetry and opportunistically searching for white-tailed fawns to capture and install VHF collars and take morphological measurements. Radio telemetry will be used to track and identify mortality events.

Who? Enthusiastic and motivated individuals who have or are working towards a degree in Biology or a related field. Applicants are required to have a valid driver's license and must be willing to work in harsh conditions.



The details: Starting salary \$14/hr for a maximum of 37.5 hrs/week. Fieldwork will be conducted around Lake Shelbyville, IL (near Sullivan, IL) with housing provided. The position starts May 15, 2023 and continues through July 1, 2023.
